

## Trumbull Public Works Snow Removal Policy

- Prior to a storm, regular weather reports are received, and manpower is made available. As the snow starts to fall, manpower is deployed on an as-needed basis. Once the storm is upgraded to *all out*, as many as 23 plow trucks and 3 supervisors are on the road.
- Please remember...emergency responders come first, so Police, Fire and EMS vehicles shall take preference.
- Main roads are plowed first, collector streets next, and dead-ends last.
- Residents are encouraged to stay home until the storm has passed and the streets have been plowed.
- Please don't shovel the end of your driveway too soon, as it will only frustrate you each time the plow goes by and fills in the area with snow.
- Please contact your trash hauler to confirm there will be pick-up before putting out your trash cans and recycling bins.
- Any objects, such as mailboxes, posts, fences, sprinkler heads, curbing, etc., within the roadway area that are damaged, should be called in to the Highway Department at (203) 452-5070 within 2 weeks of the occurrence of a storm.
- In the event that a parking ban becomes necessary, it will be posted on the Town website and announced on WTNH (channel 8), WICC 600 AM radio, and periodically on WFSB (channel 3).
