What To Bring

Household hazardous waste no longer needed 20 gallons & 20 pounds per household. We reserve the right to refuse unidentified materials and large amounts of hazardous waste.

EXAMPLES:

- * Oil Based Paints & Strippers
- * Paint Thinner, Solvents, Stains & Varnishes
- * Solvent Adhesives
- * Lighter Fluid
- * Waste Fuels: Kerosene, Gasoline
- * Engine Degreaser
- * Carburetor Cleaner, Brake Fluid
- * Transmission Fluid

- * Pesticides & Insecticides
- * Weed Killers, Moth Balls

- * Flea Powder
- * Resins & Adhesives

- * Rubber Cement, Airplane Glue
- * Hobby Supplies, Artist Supplies
- * Photo Chemicals, Chemistry Sets

- * Furniture, Floor, Metal Polishes

* **Bring materials in original containers securely closed.**

* **Pack containers in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspaper if necessary.**

* **Never mix chemicals together!!!**

* **Never smoke or eat while handling hazardous materials.**

What Not To Bring

- * Latex paint
- * Asbestos

- * Ammunition, Fireworks, Explosives
- * Radioactives, Smoke Detectors

- * Infectious & Biological Wastes
- * Prescription Drugs/Syringes
- * Commercial or Industrial Waste

- * Empty Containers
- * Compressed Gas Cylinders

- * Tires
- * Antifreeze***
- * Waste Motor Oil***
- * Car Batteries***
