

Part-Time Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)

HOURS: Maximum 19.5 per week

SALARY: Hourly Rate: \$15.00

Minimum Qualifications

- High school diploma or equivalent (GED)
- Minimum of 16 years of age (minimum 18 years of age for paid staff)
- Current state/national registry certification
- Current CPR card
- Valid driver's license (minimum age 18 to drive town vehicles with 2 years experience)
- Driving record in compliance with TEMS policy
- Effective oral, written and interpersonal communication skills
- EMT experience in active 911 service for minimum of 1 year within the last 3 years (required for paid staff)

Training Requirements

- NIMS ICS 100, 200, 700 - prior to start date
- SMART Tag - as scheduled by service if not current
- Glucometer - prior to start date
- OSHA - within calendar year

Duties and Responsibilities

- Report for duty on time and in required uniform
- Complete inventory and restocking of all ambulances at the beginning of shift; restock supplies as necessary to keep inventory at appropriate levels
- Wash and clean ambulances as needed
- Take blood pressure readings for walk-in visitors
- Share responsibility for the tidiness and cleanliness of the facility, including kitchen, day room, classroom and bedrooms
- Use the emsCharts EPCR program appropriately
- Complete all paperwork associated with the 911 calls dispatched
- Assist paramedic with ALS equipment and treatment of patients
- Provide patient care according to clinical protocols and safety requirements
- Lift and move patients as required
- Drive the ambulance or provide support to driver (minimum age 18 with 2 years driving experience to operate ambulance; paid staff required to drive)
- Communicate clearly and effectively with crew members, hospital staff, and other EMS professionals to provide information and continuity of patient care
- Make an assessment of each situation to provide optimum patient care
- Work collaboratively and cordially with all members of the service
- Perform other duties as assigned
