GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:

1. Repairs and maintains gas, diesel, 2 cycle, hydraulic, electrical and electronic systems, equipment and tools utilized within the Parks Department.
2. Performs duties requiring non-journeyman electrical, masonry, plumbing and welding skills.
3. Maintains detailed inventory and service records.
4. Performs regular duties of Parks Leadman.
5. Must be able to perform and utilize own judgment without direct supervision for troubleshooting duties.
6. Works in all types of weather, does related tasks as assigned.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED:

Works under the immediate supervision of the Superintendent of Parks.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED:

May supervise the work of one or more Park Maintainers

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS, KNOWLEDGE, SKILL AND ABILITY:

1. Ability to diagnose problems, particularly mechanical problems and devise methods for solving problems.
2. Knowledge of the mechanisms of gasoline, diesel and 2 cycle driven equipment and tools, as well as, hydraulic, electrical and electronic systems.
3. Ability to interpret and use trade journals and manuals to learn new approaches to problems.
4. Good knowledge of basic principles of electrical, plumbing, masonry and welding trades.
5. Basic ability to use a Computer and Word and Excel programs for record keeping.
6. Considerable physical strength, stamina, and ability to lift at least 80 lbs.
7. Utilization of electrical diagnostic testing equipment.
8. Provides own tools of the trade.
9. Must possess current valid Connecticut CDL, Class B (Commercial Driver's License).

EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING:

High School Diploma or GED. Not less than five (5) years of employment in the operation and repair and maintenance of turf and field maintenance equipment.
