GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES:

1. Repairs and maintains gas and diesel trucks, automobiles, tractors, road machinery, small or 2 cycle engines, and various types of construction, and landscape equipment.
2. Has experience in wiring of vehicles and equipment.
3. Knowledge of hydraulic systems.
4. Welding of equipment.
5. Required to work emergency and all other overtime, as needed.
6. Maintains inventories and fills out service records,
7. Works in all types of weather conditions.
8. Does all related work, as required.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED:

Works under the supervision of the Director of Public Works or his designee who assigns specific repair tasks and gives instructions as to the manner in which they are to be performed; follows established routines in servicing automotive and tractor and landscape equipment. Work is inspected in progress and upon completion.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED:

May supervise one or more helpers.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS, KNOWLEDGE, SKILL AND ABILITY:

1. Knowledge of the mechanisms of diesel trucks, heavy construction equipment, automobiles and various types of small gas driven equipment and tools.
2. Ability to use and care for the tools of the trade, bench and testing equipment, lathe and drill press.
3. Considerable physical strength.
4. Ability to keep shop records.
5. Use of electrical diagnostic test equipment.
6. Provides own tools of the trade.

EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING:

High School Diploma or GED. Not less than five (5) years of employment in repair of diesel trucks and gas engines and heavy construction equipment. Must possess current valid CDL, Class B (Commercial Driver's License).
