SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAM**

The Town of Trumbull announces that it is now accepting applications for summer employment for the following positions.

ID CHECKERS: Must be at least 16 years old-Gatekeepers at Beach and Tashua pools-approximately 10-15 hours per week will be trained in CPR and basic 1st aid.

LIFEGUARDS: Must be at least 16 years old. Applicants must present a valid Lifesaving certificate issued by the American Red Cross, a valid First Aid certificate and a valid CPR for the Professional Rescuer/AED certificate at the time of application. Lifeguard applications are accepted year round. All certification forms must be submitted prior to employment.

PLAYGROUND LEADERS: Must be at least entering college-18 years old and be able to be certified in CPR, 1st aid and AED and have experience working with children. Playground leaders work approximately 30 hours per week. Applicants with at least one year of college and experience with children will be given preference. Appointees must agree to work the FULL eight-week period starting approximately at the end of the school year.

SPORTS CLINICS: Must be at least 16 years old-work various sports clinics-Baseball, Basketball, Volleyball, Track, Tennis-approximately 15 hours per week for approximately 4 weeks, Experience: Ability and knowledge of the above sports.

GENERAL MAINTENANCE WORK: In the Highway and Park departments only. Please contact the board of education for custodial positions for the summer. Applicants will be judged on prior work records, physical ability to perform the work and general aptitude. Must have reached their 17th birthday by 5/14/15.

CLERICALS: In the Town Hall. Must be proficient in Word and Excel & reached their 17th birthday by 5/14/15.
