November 8th is Election Day!

On Tuesday, November 8th, each elector has the right, the opportunity and the privilege to vote in the local election. When electors take advantage of voting, they also take part in a process that was written by our forefathers, and fought for by the brave men and women who will be remembered on Veterans' Day. If you are an elector in Trumbull, there are seven (7) polling locations that will be open from 6 a.m. until 8 p.m.

**District 1 casts their votes at Hillcrest Middle School;
District 2 at Booth Hill Elementary School;
District 3 at Tashua Elementary School;
District 4 at Jane Ryan Elementary School;
District 5 at Middlebrook Elementary School;
District 6 at Madison Middle School and
District 7 at Frenchtown Elementary School.**

If you are unsure of where you vote, please contact the Elections Administration Office, Registrar of Voters, at (203)452-5059(5058). They will be able to assist you. The last day to register to vote is Tuesday, 11/1/2011 and it is in person only. The Elections office will be open from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. The Town Clerk's Office will be open on Saturday, 11/5/2011 from 9 a.m. until noon to obtain your absentee ballot and vote. All absentee ballots must be received by 8p.m. on Election Day. You CANNOT bring in your ballot on that day.
