

ARTS COMMISSION

April 13, 2010

Meeting was called to order at 5:10 p.m. by Chairman Andrea Endresz-Vlachos.

It was unanimously agreed to by the Commission to have Diane Wheeler co-chair the Arts Commission with Andrea Endresz-Vlachos. Note: The Commission is still three members short.

Coordinator's Report: Emily reported that everything is going along fine with the Arts Festival. Her committee juried the crafts that have come in and they have chosen 34 crafters from the entries received. Eighteen artists have also been chosen.

This year entry fee was reduced from \$100 to \$75.

Motion made by Gloria Murphy; seconded by Diane Wheeler to approve \$250 to be used as award money for the annual Submissions Competition of Broken Shells. Motion carried unanimously.

Emily reported that the revenue from the monthly concerts totaled \$2,055 for the October through March concerts.

The Commission tentatively approved the following performers for the 2010-11 season based upon the availability of them: October – Radio Ranch (country western); November – Ash Creek String Band; January – Mikata-Samba; February – Michael and Dr. Joe; March – The Kerry Boys or River City Slim; April – White Eye Lizard or River City Slim; May – Fiesta del Norte-Mariachi.

Request received from the Memorial Day Parade Committee asking to use our sound system for the upcoming Memorial Day Parade. The ceremonies this year will be before the parade.

Motion made by Diane Wheeler; seconded by Gloria Murphy to approve use of the sound system by the Memorial Day Parade Committee. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made to adjourn made by Gloria Murphy; seconded by Judy Edwards.
