MINUTES
JANUARY 5, 2016

CALL TO ORDER: The Chair called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

The following is a brief summary of the meeting. A complete record is on tape, on file, in the office of the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Commission located in the Trumbull Town Hall.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Application 15-31 Joe Manco

Permit approval to install an above ground pool and deck within a regulated area at 136 Sterling Road

Mr. Manco, 136 Sterling Road, attended and presented his application to the commission. According to the original paperwork, his property contains wetlands as well as a stream in the back. A soil scientist was hired to test the property and the results changed the boundaries with the majority now being uplands. Pool will be in the upland review area. Upon the recommendation of the IWWC Agent the area was flagged along the watercourse which is where the 100' upland review area comes in. According to Mr. Manco the pool will be an above ground 27' round pool and will be placed in what is now a grass area. The Commission asked if any paving from the house to the pool would be done. Mr. Manco replied there would not be. A deck will be added at a later date. The Commission asked for a clarification of deck size with a best guess. The deck will be approximately 250 sq. ft. Mr. Manco presented into record an aerial photograph which shows the tree line to give a better prospective on how close the pool would be to the tree line. No tree removal would be required. The Commission inquired about where the water would be drained if the need should arise with the concern of chlorinated water running into the stream. Mr. Manco would consult with neighbors who now have pools. He would also have no issue if Commission were to put in a stipulation that there would be no drainage of the pool towards the stream or hiring a pool company if need be. The pool filter will be located close to deck.

Motion (Girourd), seconded (DeFeo) to CLOSE New Business VOTE: Motion CARRIED unanimously. New Business CLOSED at 7:15 p.m.
