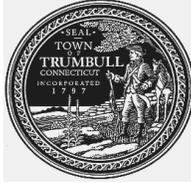

NOTICE is hereby given that the LEGISLATION & ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE of the Trumbull Town Council will hold a regular meeting on Monday, July 26, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. at the Trumbull Town Hall, for the following purpose:

1. RESOLUTION TC23-78: To consider and act upon a resolution which would approve the funding for a labor contract between the Town of Trumbull and AFSCME LOCAL 1303-33 (DPW) Trumbull Highway And Parks Employees beginning January 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2012.
2. RESOLUTION TC23-83: To consider and act upon a resolution pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes 7-148 that the Town of Trumbull Building Department shall withhold the approval of building applications for any property upon which taxes or sewer charges are delinquent for the property for which the permit is to be issued. The delinquent taxes, along with applicable interest, fees and charges, shall be paid before a building permit application can be approved. (**Public Hearing**)
3. RESOLUTION TC23-88: To consider and act upon a resolution which would appropriate \$45,217 for Attorney Fees for MATE Arbitration Award Settlement from

the Available General Fund Balance to 0101300-522203 Human Resources Ancillary. (L&A)

4. RESOLUTION TC23-90: To consider and act upon a resolution which would authorize Timothy M. Herbst, the First Selectman of the Town of Trumbull to apply and sign for on behalf of the Town of Trumbull, a Small Town Economic Assistance Program grant in the amount of \$80,000 for expansion of the parking lots at Beach Park and Indian Ledge Park. (L&A) (*Public Hearing*)

RESOLUTIONS

1. RESOLUTION TC23-78: BE IT RESOLVED, that funding for a labor contract between the Town of Trumbull and AFSCME LOCAL 1303-33 (DPW) Trumbull Highway And Parks Employees beginning January 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2012 is hereby approved.
2. RESOLUTION TC23-83: BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, That pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes 7-148, the approval of building applications by the Town of Trumbull Building Department shall be withheld for any property upon which taxes or sewer charges are delinquent for the property for which the permit is to be issued. The delinquent taxes, along with applicable interest, fees and charges, shall be paid before a building permit application can be approved.
3. RESOLUTION TC23-88: BE IT RESOLVED, That \$45,217 for Attorney Fees for MATE Arbitration Award Settlement is hereby appropriated from the Available General Fund Balance to 0101300-522203 Human Resources Ancillary.
4. RESOLUTION TC23-90: BE IT RESOLVED, That Timothy M. Herbst, the First Selectman of the Town of Trumbull, is hereby authorized to apply and sign for on behalf of the Town of Trumbull, a Small Town Economic Assistance Program grant in the amount of \$80,000 for expansion of the parking lots at Beach Park and Indian Ledge Park.
