TC25-72 FULL RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION TC25-72: BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, That Section 6, Enforcement of Provisions False Alarm Abatement of the Trumbull Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting Section (a) *Failure to register* and replacing said section with the following: Section (a) *Failure to register*. Any alarm user as defined in Section 1 herein, who fails to register their alarm system, will be issued a warning by the Trumbull Police Department to register their alarm within 30 calendar days. The alarm user will receive an alarm registration form at the time said warning is issued and must register within 30 calendar days of receipt. If registration is not made within 30 calendar days of the receipt of the warning, the alarm user will be charged \$100 for that year and for each year said alarm is not registered. In addition the alarm user shall pay \$50.00 for each false alarm until the alarm system is registered in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance.
