1. RESOLUTION TC25-73: To consider and act upon a resolution which would approve an agreement between the Town of Trumbull and Trumbull Loves Children Inc.
2. RESOLUTION TC25-79: To consider and act upon a resolution which would approve the following programs as eligible under the Neighborhood Assistance Act; St. Vincent's Special Needs Center, Inc. Augmentative Communication Services -\$20,000, Southwestern Area Health Education Center, Inc. Special Smiles in Greater Bridgeport - \$10,000, Connecticut Radio Information System, Inc.
