The Connecticut Neighborhood Assistance Act (NAA) Tax Credit Program is designed to provide funding for municipal and tax exempt organizations through business tax credit incentives for businesses that make cash contributions to approved entities. Businesses can receive a credit of 60% of contributions to organizations approved by the CT Department of Revenue Services.
