The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**Call to Order**

Elizabeth Mastroianni, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.in the Long Hill Conference Room at the Town Hall, Trumbull, Connecticut.

**Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes**

The minutes of the 4/23/14 meeting were motioned for approval by Fran Basbagill and seconded by Rosemarie Derrig. Vote was unanimous.

Elizabeth Mastroianni said that we still need a Vice Chairman, Secretary, and sub-committee persons for Volunteers and Grounds. It was decided to table these decisions until next week.

**New Business**

Elizabeth Mastroianni reported that Lynn Arnow and Amy DeZenzo have booked the fireworks and Marenda Amusement.

**Port-o-Potties**

Elizabeth Mastroianni reported that Royal Flush came back with a decrease in their proposal and would provide a standby truck for pumping at \$85 per hour. Fran Basbagill motioned to contract Royal Flush. Rich Pulie seconded. Vote was unanimous.

**Pink Ponies**

The Pink Pony Company has other commitments and cannot commit at this time to provide their services. Fran Basbagill suggested another company that she is aware of. The matter will be tabled until more information is received.

**Vendors**

Elizabeth Mastroianni received an e-mail from Pro Wrestling Tonight with answers to her questions. They would have three matches averaging 20 minutes each. There would be a \$10 charge per person to get into the ring and \$10 for a picture. They would provide local professional wrestlers that have been well trained and perform a kid friendly show. They said there is minimal to no damage to the fields. He also has assured us that the professional wrestling is extremely safe and the

audience is kept far away from the action. To date there have been no injuries of any kind. They have agreed to work on a barter system of entertainment for vendor space. Elizabeth will try to have four matches instead of three.

Stephanie Peters suggested that Tim Herbst contact Linda McMahon to have WWE wrestlers walk around the grounds and possibly take pictures with anyone interested. She said this would likely attract more patrons. Fran Basbagill motioned to contract Pro Wrestling Tonight as a barter vendor. Rich Pulie seconded. Vote was unanimous.

### **Food Vendors**

Rosemarie Derrig reported that many requests have been received. After the deadline of May 15<sup>th</sup>, all applications will be reviewed by the Commission and decisions will be made.

### **Entertainment**

Kim Vecchione was not present at the meeting but sent an e-mail out regarding the entertainment timeline and summary she has set up so far. Some of the entertainment will include Roaming Railroad, Race Remote Controlled Cars, Lynn Lewis & Friends, Just Dance Studios, Bollywood Dancing and some bands.

### **Security**

Elizabeth Mastroianni reviewed quotes from other companies and none of them have scanners. It was suggested to contact the company we had last year, USA Security, and advise them of the problems we had with them last year and the over payment discrepancies on last year's invoice. Kim Vecchione told us at a previous meeting that she knows someone who has a security business and Elizabeth would like to have more information on them. Right now, everything is on hold until we find out from Amy DeZenzo and Lynn Arnow exactly what will be needed.

Elizabeth Mastroianni will try to get on the schedule for the Board of Education Meeting next Tuesday, May 6<sup>th</sup>, to obtain permission from the Board regarding drinking throughout the grounds. She will try to work the presentation around our Trumbull Day Meeting on the same night.

Much of the finalization of planning revolves around the site plans that Amy DeZenzo and Lynn Arnow will be providing.

Fran Basbagill motioned the meeting be adjourned at 8:05 pm. Rich Pulie seconded. Motion carried.
