Optimum will sponsor the stage

\$1000 in field vendor money is in already

Vendors need to commit

Food vendors – Subway is not coming this year. Rose is looking for a new grinder place. Rose will ask Frank Valenti if he would like to add grinders to his space for an extra \$400. If not, Rose will ask Vazzy if he would like to do it and pay an extra \$600.

Rose is looking for more food vendors, Greek, Seafood and Thai food. Maybe ask the O Bar if he would like to rent a spot and advertise and showcase the food from his new place that will be in Trumbull Center.

Rose said that the ice cream vendor (Sprinkles) this year will be paying \$1200 and Preston would have liked them to pay the \$1500, but will leave it as is for this year.

San Remo has two spots in the tent

Mapping out of spots is needed

Vendors have all called the Health and will have to have their paperwork in by May 26<sup>th</sup>.

Rose is over budget by \$450 and she asked if she could move forward as is. Preston said she could if her contract with the people stated that they would not get paid if it rained! She will e-mail the contract to Dana to make sure it is worded correctly before she mails them out to the entertainers.

So Preston motioned to move forward with this and everyone was in favor.

Wild Life Show, Birds of Prey, Magician and Balloon Artist Amazing Andy), Stilt Walking Pony Rides, and the Magician and Balloon Artist (The Great Sirico) are booked so far.

It was discussed that the stage should be moved for the sound effects to the fireworks. Power has to be able to reach the stage.

Charter has its own generator's and WEBE will be coming to broadcast and would supply the speakers.

Simone's sound budget is \$3500, maybe \$4000

Preston will call Don Walsh about the electricity

Preston thought that the fireworks without the music would be better because there would be more fireworks. Everyone pretty much agreed and a motion was made that they should drop the music.

Fire truck and five men will be \$30 an hour from the time the fireworks arrive until after the fireworks have ended.

Rides and lemonade - \$13,500
