John gave Preston \$5100 in checks collected from the field vendors and will be collecting checks until Monday, June 22, 2009.

Tower lights are need at each gate (PD talked to Tom Baldwin already)

Preston thought that instead of an electrician running power that Trumbull Day could use towers instead, for \$175 each. Towers are needed at each gate and a few in the middle of the field. Do not commit to any vendors using Trumbull Day power. In prior years the school had their lights on also.

Some people don't have their own generators. Trumbull Day Committee does not want to commit to vendors using Trumbull Day Power.

Simone wants to make sure that someone will be there to watch the equipment. Simone will find out how many amps and circuits are needed. Stage will be the same as last year.

The extrication of the car is all set.

Trumbull Day is in good shape with 5-10 thousand available, Joe Ruospo made a motion to increase the budget and Rose Derrig seconded it, all were in favor and it was passed.

Preston Merritt said that Stewart Amusement did offer them a trailer for an office. There will be a money pick up at 8 p.m. and at the end of the night.

Joe Ruospo was asked if he could get zipper bags for the money.

Simone asked if Trumbull Day could get an ATM machine and maybe Trumbull Day could split the fees. Maybe raise the fee and then split it. (have to find out how much electricity it needs)
