

TRUMBULL SENIOR CITIZEN COMMISSION
June 5, 2009
MINUTES

Call to Order: The Chairman, Mr. Monaco called the Senior Citizen Commission special meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

Present: C. Cleary, S. Daniels, D. Tkacs, and H. Weinstein, W. Dick, C. Donnelly and Joan Melhorn.

Also Present: J. Ferreira, Center Director.

Review of the Minutes:

Ms. Daniels and Ms. Tkacs moved and seconded to approve the May 22, 2009 meeting minutes as submitted. VOTE: Motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Report:

Mr. Monaco requested the help of the Senior Citizen Commission members on Trumbull Day. The Trumbull Day Senior Bingo will be held at the Senior Center. The day before the event the commission has a meeting scheduled, anyone who can stay after the meeting to help would be appreciated, this day is the day everything will be prepared, so it is especially important to have volunteers on June 26, 2009. Hot dogs, chips and macaroni salad will be prepared and given as a packaged lunch at the bingo. A registration table volunteer is needed the day of the bingo. Mr. Monaco suggested that the commissioners and volunteers wear I.D. tags the day of the event. All monetary donations will go into the Trumbull Day Bingo account. Ms. Ferreira requested volunteers to go to certain stores to purchase the gift cards that will be given out as bingo prizes. Any extra gift cards at the end of the bingo will be raffled off. The Senior Center mugs will be given out with the gift cards as prizes. St. Joseph" Manor and Maefair will be donating the jello and pudding. Ms. Ferreira will try to contact the bingo callers, such as the first selectman, the Judge of Probate, the Tax Collector and the Town Clerk to see if they will be available on Trumbull Day. Ms. Ferreira stated that they would start the bingo with the Pledge of Allegiance. One of the prizes will be 4 ferry tickets to Port Jefferson. Mr. Jones of the Senior Center will use the video cameras to broadcast to the lower level. All present agreed on the menu planned for the Trumbull day Senior Bingo. Tickets (2 different colors) will be used for the lunch and raffle. There will be no punch served, soda in cans will be. Servers will be needed the day of the bingo, please call Ms. Ferreira ahead of time if you are able to volunteer.

Ms. Cleary and Ms. Tkacs moved and seconded to approve the appropriation not to exceed \$500.00 to supplement the Smile Awhile group's purchase of shirts. Vote: Motion approved unanimously.

The washer and dryer discussed at the last meeting have been purchased at a cost of \$899.00.

The Craft Fair is scheduled for August 30, 2009 on the town Hall Green, volunteers are needed to chalk the lines, signs advertising the event will be professionally printed this year.

Ms. Melhorn met with the Town attorney to discuss Dr. Ruby's property purchase. The town will not take a mortgage for any property. Further discussions are needed, Ms. Melhorn will report back at a later date on this issue.

Ms. Fereira suggested that the senior center have a New Year's Ball this year at the Marriott, with a ticket price of \$50.00 per person. The commission will discuss this in further detail at a later meeting.

Adjournment:

Ms. Melhorn and Ms. Tkacs moved and seconded to adjourn. There being no further business to discuss the Senior Center Commission adjourned by unanimous consent at 1:49 p.m.
