Chairman Biagioni called the public hearing to order at 7:40 p.m.

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING - TOWN OF TRUMBULL W.P.C.A.
SANITARY SEWER EASEMENT ACQUISITION
PHASE IV, PART B, CONTRACT III • JOG HILL AREA**

Pursuant to Section 7-255 of the Connecticut General Statutes, the Trumbull Water Pollution Control Authority hereby gives notice of a Public Hearing, January 24, 2007, at 7:30 P.M. in the Town Hall Council Chambers, Trumbull, Connecticut. The purpose of this hearing is the acquisition of a perpetual right of way of sanitary sewer easement at 296 Daniels Farm Road, for the purpose of constructing the designed sanitary sewer system, Phase IV, Part B, Contract III, also known as the Jog Hill Area sewer project.

Mr. Solemene addressed the Commission. He stated that the property is located at the corner of Daniels Farm Road and Hedgehog Road. In order to avoid a new Town-installed culvert on Hedgehog Road, the sewer main will cross the corner of the property, go down Hedgehog Road and back down Daniels Farm Road. The homeowner has been cooperative and will sign the agreement. There was no one in attendance to speak for or against the application.

**PUBLIC HEARING
167-B BROADWAY**

Pursuant to Section 7-247a of the Connecticut General Statutes, the Trumbull Water Pollution Control Authority hereby gives notice of its intention to conduct a public hearing, Wednesday, January 24, 2007, in the Council Chambers of Town Hall, 5866 Main Street, Trumbull, Connecticut. Applicant is seeking permission to saddle the existing sewer main on Broadway and install a 6" PVC lateral connection to serve an existing home located at 167-B Broadway. Applicant: Mark Provenzano

Applicant Mark Provenzano was present to speak to the Commission. Mr. Provenzano owns both the parcel of land known as 167-A & B Broadway. While 167-A Broadway is connected to the sanitary sewer system, 167-B Broadway is on a septic system built in 1929. Mr. Provenzano proposes connecting 167-B Broadway to the sanitary

sewer system through an easement on the property. Mr. Provenzano will pay a full assessment for the new connection. There was no one present to speak against the application.
