- **Inspectors' Daily Reports** – All reports are filed and available for inspection in the Engineering Department. It would be time/memory consuming to scan and e-mail each report every day to all members of the Commission. Is that what the Commissioners would like.
- **Trench Compaction** – request clarification. Compaction tests required at intervals of 100 feet along trench at various levels. $5,280 \text{ feet per mile} \times 20 \text{ miles by } 100 = 1,056 \times 3 = 3,168 \text{ tests} \times \$55 \text{ each} = \$174,240$
- **Penny Items** – Based on the asterisk notation (Bid: Page 9 of 21) the Commission has determined the right to require the Contractor to install items 57 through 63 at the discretion of the Inspector in the field. This requires a motion.
 - **Quantities were modified by the Town based on previous experiences of new sanitary sewer installations in existing roads. The location and placement of these extra items not indicated on the drawings, if required, will be at the discretion of the Town Road Inspector in the field. Unit prices will prevail.**
