14 Mohawk Drive: Sewer Connection

Mr. Smeriglio stated 14 Mohawk is a new dwelling as a result of a property having been subdivided into two properties. The owner is seeking the approval of this commission to connect to the sanitary sewer system at the Daniels Farms Road sewer main. The department is reviewing the plan for details. Seeking WPCA approval for a sewer connection was a conditions of approval for the subdivision. Once they come in for a building permit, the assessment process will be initiated. The assessment will be \$24,653.50. The owner, Mr. Joseph Giacobbe of the property was present and indicated the project would start in two weeks and it is expected to finish within five months. The sewer connection will be made by Anthony Julian and would be completed in a day. Mr. Smeriglio recommended approval of the sewer connection.
