Chairman Biagioni called the public hearing to order at 7:30 p.m.

Commissioner Goncalves read aloud the following public hearing notice:

"Pursuant to Section 7-247a of the Connecticut General Statutes, the Trumbull Water Pollution Control Authority hereby gives notice of its intention to conduct a Public Hearing regarding the proposed sanitary sewer extension to an existing project labeled Phase IV – Part B – Contract III. The proposed extension will provide service to the following 13 homes on Hurd Road: 69, 72, 78, 79, 82, 83, 86, 89, 92, 95, 98, 102, 105.

The Trumbull Water Pollution Control Authority will conduct a Public Hearing Wednesday, February 11, 2009 at 7:30 p.m. in the Long Hill Room at Trumbull Town Hall, 5866 Main Street, Trumbull, Connecticut, to hear all affected property owners and other interested persons."

Mr. Solemene explained the design of the sewer extension stopped at the intersection of Hurd Road and Ranch Drive, leaving out this small section of Hurd Road. Mr. Solemene was not aware that the design did not include this section, and a manhole was installed on Greenbrier Road to accept this section. A house-to-house survey was conducted, and the majority of the residents are in favor of the extension. Mr. Solemene feels the 13 homes should be included.

There being no one to speak for or against the sewer extension,

- **Motion made (GONCALVES) seconded (AIELLO) to close the public hearing. No discussion. Motion carried unanimously.**
- **Motion made (GONCALVES) seconded (AIELLO) to approve the following homes on Hurd Road as an extension to the existing sewer project: 69, 72, 78, 79, 82, 83, 86, 89, 92, 95, 98, 102, 105. No discussion. Motion carried unanimously.**

There being no other business before the Authority,

- **Motion (GONCALVES) seconded (AIELLO) to adjourn. No discussion. Motion carried unanimously.**

The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
