Chairman Biagioni called the meeting to order at 7:40 p.m.

MINUTES TO PREVIOUS MEETING:

- Motion by Goncalves, seconded by Francese, to accept the minutes of the January 24, 2007 meeting as written. Motion carried unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mr. Solemene presented an invoice from Mark IV Construction Co. for the cost of the repair of the Old Town Road pump station in the amount of \$1,802 for time and materials.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. Solemene reported on a meeting with developer Bob Scinto, who is proposing to extend a sewer main into Monroe to serve the proposed Jewish Home for the Elderly. The parcel is located in Monroe behind the school bus depot on Spring Hill Road. The bus depot is connected to sewers with a force main, which pumps up to the Trefoil Drive pump station. At present there is no design, and the first step would be getting approval from the W.P.C.A. Chairman Biagioni referenced the W.P.C.A. policy not to negotiate with developers wishing to connect parcels to the Trumbull sewer system from outside the town borders, and to only negotiate with municipalities that intend to sewer their town. Mr. Solemene stated that there was a meeting on the subject which included the mayor of Bridgeport, a representative from the town of Monroe and First Selectman Baldwin of Trumbull. Mr. Solemene also stated that this proposal is exclusive to this one parcel. After some discussion it was decided to table this item until a future meeting.

PROPOSED SEWER CONNECTION – AUTUMN RIDGE ROAD

Siting septic system failure, Gary Beers of 88 Autumn Ridge Road is proposing to connect his home and 92 Autumn Ridge Road to the existing sewer main on Fox Road.

- **Motion by Goncalves, seconded by Francese, to hold a public hearing on March 28, 2007, to consider the application to connect 88 and 92 Autumn Ridge Road to the Trumbull Sewer System. Motion carried unanimously.**

There being no other business before the Authority,

- **Motion to adjourn by Goncalves, seconded by Biagioni. Motion carried unanimously.**

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The meeting was adjourned at 9:15 p.m.
