

TRUMBULL CONSERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 29, 2008
NICHOLS ROOM AT TOWN HALL

Meeting called to order by John Russell at 7:40 pm. In attendance were Don Watson, Dale Parsons, Joanne Parsons, and Julie Jenkins.

Minutes from the last meeting accepted unanimously.

Meeting dates are set for the last Thursday in each month. November meeting will be moved to 20th, December meeting will be set for 18th to accommodate holidays. January, 2009 will return to the fourth Thursday.

Discussion ensued about getting posted on the town website. Don presented a short description of our commission. Julie made a motion to accept the description, seconded by Dale, unanimously accepted. Don will talk to the town about inclusion on the town website.

Julie presented a proposal for a newspaper article for inclusion in either the Trumbull Times or The Review. It was agreed upon and will be presented by Julie to the First Selectman's office for perusal.

Discussion ensued about Hidden Pond Development. Julie presented a report on a walk on September 16, 2008. A report from Lars Jorgensen was read about possible contamination of the soil. Joanne said she would check on a report from Environmental Land Solutions that was asked for by the town. The public hearing at the Inland Wetlands on this property is October 7. We were all encouraged to attend.

John had not heard back about dollars for membership in conservation groups.

Joanne made a motion, seconded by Don to approve the letter drafted about Hidden Pond. It will be presented to the Inland Wetlands Commission meeting October 7, 2008.
