

Trumbull Ethics Commission
June 22, 2013 at 8:00 am

On June 22, 2013, at 8:03 a.m., the Trumbull Ethics Commission convened in the Long Hill Room, Town Hall, Trumbull, Connecticut.

Commission Chairman, Thomas E. Lee, and Commissioners Frank Scifo, M.D. and John M. Varrone, were in attendance constituting a quorum.

The Chairman, Thomas E. Lee, brought the meeting to order. On motion made and seconded, the minutes from the meeting of June 11, 2013 were then unanimously approved by the Commission Members present and voting.

Thereafter, a motion was made by Commissioner, John M. Varrone, to go into Executive Session to continue the investigation of Complaint 2013-1 seconded by Commissioner Frank Scifo, M.D. and unanimously approved, the Commission went into Executive Session at 8:10 a.m. with Attorney James A. Trowbridge in attendance as the Attorney for the Commission.

Thereafter, at 11:47 a.m., the Trumbull Ethics Commission on motion made and seconded and unanimously approved by the members present and voting came out of Executive Session and came back into regular session, noting no votes were taken during the Executive Session.

Commissioner Frank Scifo, M.D. – Yes


The motion to dismiss the complaint known as 2013-1 as to Respondent #4 was unanimously approved.
