Chair Tom Lee invited public to respond.

Motion was made by Chairman Tom Lee to accept the request for a continuance by respondent's attorney, Bruce Elstein, not to exceed 30 days due to his ill health. Seconded By Bill Brown. No Discussion. Unanimously voted to accept.

The Chair noted that the respondent desired the Hearing to be held in private in accord with Section 17 D (ii) of the Town Charter, but the Commission had not dealt with this as yet. Attorney Stephen Wright filling in for Attorney Elstein who was in ill health indicated that the respondent agreed with continuance and waived the requirement of the hearing commencing within 45 days as a result of the continuance.
