Trumbull Day has returned to its traditional June weekend! This year, the event will host a carnival, numerous food trucks, a Cornhole tournament, a dunk tank, and a variety of musical entertainment on **Thursday, June 28th and Friday, June 29th from 6 p.m. until 11 p.m., and SUNDAY, July 1st from 1 p.m. until 11 p.m.** Dreamland Amusements will provide games and 19 rides, ranging from spectacular to kiddie, for folks of all ages. There will be a family-friendly food area with a beer and wine tent, along with live entertainment all three days. New this year is a Cornhole tournament for those 18 years of age and older. Sunday will end with a magnificent fireworks display from **Bay Fireworks** at dusk. Ride bracelets will be available for purchase *each day* and admission to Trumbull Day will be *free!*
