1. Are partial Bids Acceptable?  
Response: Yes
2. Item #02 Will the Notebook cart specified NETBOOK32, fit the X131e notebooks?  
Response: confirm with the manufacturer.
3. Item # 04 Network Care Packs, need confirmation of the qty needed for each model, and what the HP part numbers are for each switch.  
Response: See #13
4. Are the switches currently under warranty, if so, what is the expiration date. So we can coordinate support packs.  
Response: They are under the HP lifetime warranty
5. Item #06 Camera's ELMO CO-10 is discontinued, Recommended replacement MO-1, will this be OK?  
Response: OK
6. Is there volume licensing for the software/applications loading onto the notebooks  
Response: Provide the most competitive software/applications pricing option.
7. Do you have an imaging tool to Ghost the images for the notebooks?  
Response: No
8. If Substitutions or Alternative solutions are being presented, should the Alternative be listed on the Proposal form, or should the requested solution be listed with the alternative given an addition?  
Response: Bid the specified items and include alternatives as desired.
9. Just to clarify is a Certificate of Insurance required with the bid submittal.  
Response: No, it is to be provided by the Contractor, to the Town, prior to the start of work.
10. Is a 10% Bid Bond absolutely necessary in order to submit a proposal?  
Response: Yes
11. Are there an addendums out?  
Response: No addenda have been issued, at this time.
12. Is imaging needed for the laptops in section 02? Is onsite configuration needed as far as naming / domaining for each laptop?  
Response: Yes
13. What are the exact part numbers of the HP 5400 and 3500 switches? Is it only Qty 1 for each switch? OR is it Qty 25 Carepacks for the HP 5400 and Qty 1 for the 3500?  
Response: 5406 and 3500, quantity 1 for the 5406 and quantity 25 for the 3500s.
14. On the IP Server? A Full rack is needed / required? I understand providing the power strips and UPS, but wasn't sure if there was available space within the current MDF Rack?  
Response: Provide the racking solution required for your proposed system.
