The Stern Village Neighborhood Watch (SVNW) kicked off in May. They will be on the grounds at different times during the day and night checking for parking violations and help keep the community safe. They will issue parking violations and call the police if your vehicle is parked illegally.

SECURITY AND SPEED BUMPS:

Speed bumps have been installed. You will see additional signs throughout the village to deter speeders. Wireless security cameras have been installed around the village for your safety and to deter any criminal activity.

PARKING IN STERN VILLAGE:

Stern Village residents will be required to have a THA sticker placed in inside front windshield of their car. Parking violations will be enforced. If you receive a third violation, your car **WILL BE TOWED**. If you do not have a sticker, get one at the office. Alert the THA if your car information changes.
