Chief's Report

Correspondence

Letter from Chief Salvatore, Monroe Police Department thanking Officer Ruiz for his assistance with translating a suspect during arrest processing and interviews.

Operations

Chief Lombardo reviewed the Calls-for-Service report for the month of November. There was a total of 1736 calls.

The Motor Vehicle Enforcement report showed the MV Warning, DUI Arrests, MV Complaints and MV Arrests. There was a total of 168 for the month of November.

Chief Lombardo reviewed the Criminal Incidents report for the month of November, which showed a total of 72 calls.

Chief Lombardo review the Alarm Response report for the month of November, which showed a total of 148 calls.

Chief Lombardo reviewed the Incident Statistics Report for the month of November, which showed a total of 1737 alarms.

Chief Lombardo reviewed the School Resource Officers Reports (SRO Bartosik, Duva and Massa) for the month of November.

The Arrest Summary Report Adults showed there were 50 arrests for the month of November.

Chief Lombardo reviewed the Canine Officers Report from K-9 Officer Carlson. The report provided details of the types of calls they assisted. K-9 Officer Lee is still working with his new K-9.

Traffic Division

The Traffic Report showed 62 cases for the month of November.

Officer Harry trained Officers Ball and Pinzon on Radar and Laaser Certification.

Detective Division Report

Chief Lombardo reviewed the Detective Division Monthly Activity report for the month of November. The division opened six new case, three cases were closed and have 22 cases still open.

Chief Lombardo reviewed the Monthly Status report for November, which provided more detail on the cases detectives are working on. Chief Lombardo reported that three cars were stolen the morning of Thanksgiving. Each car had the keys or key fab inside. Chief Lombardo reminded the public again to lock your cars and take your keys.

Training

Chief Lombardo reviewed the Training Report for the month of November. The report showed the type of training and the officers who attended the training. There were two Community Police events the Department participated in, TPAUD Underage Drinking Forum and Coffee with a Cop at the Senior Center.

Chris Russo of Russo & Rizio, LLC on behalf of 7120 Main Street, the traffic report that the Commission has is for a larger capacity facility but was reduced. Michael Dion interrupted Mr. Russo of BL Companies and indicated that is not correct. BL Companies did the traffic impact study for the applicant. The client has been going back on forth on the size of facility. They have now settled with what was submitted in the traffic study originally.

There was suggestion by Commissioner Labella to table the item.

Mr. Russo understood as they Commission was not given enough time. Mr. Russo asked if possible the Commission would hold a Special meeting as this is a significant application for the town and they feel the property that has been dormant for a long time and finally has good use.

Chairman Baldwin requested that the proper study be provide to Chief Lombardo and he will then forward to the Commission for review.

7120 Main Street Traffic Consideration of Approval, Rob Librandi-Planning & Zoning
Rob Librandi and Bill Maurer from Planning & Zoning were present. Mr. Librandi explained the 7120 Main Street application is going before Planning and Zoning Commission on December 18, 2019. Mr. Librandi asked that the applicant provide to him along with the Commission an update on the Traffic Study conducted, as there have been some modifications. Mr. Librandi thanked the Commission for having this Special meeting to review the application.

Mr. Rizio indicated that he believes this is one of the best spots in the Town of Trumbull to have this warehouse.

Chairman Baldwin asked Officer Harry after reviewing the study if he sees any concerns that need to be addressed.

Officer Harry indicated it is tough depending on the shifts of the warehouse there might be some complications with the buses, especially on school delays. Restriction of the right in and right out onto the southbound driveway closer Spring Hill Road would alleviate traffic issues. People leaving the property will need to merge on to existing traffic and could be less of an impact to traffic as they already have the right of way on Main Street or Spring Hill Road.

Mr. Librandi asked if there would be signage in the area indicating tractor-trailer only access or anything to that effect.

Mr. Dion indicated he has not seen anything on the signage.

Mr. Rizio will look at this before the P&Z meeting and they will do any accommodations.

Mr. Librandi mentioned that if the Commission has any other concerns or questions, they could write a letter to him.

Chairman Baldwin asked if there were any other questions or concerns.

Vice Chairman Magliocco indicated at the moment the way this project is being presented maybe be acceptable. He is concerned in the growth in the future.

There was no further discussion.

A motion was made by Vazzano to approve subject to approval of the State Traffic Commission and any recommendations made to come back to the Trumbull Police Commission for 7120 Main Street in Trumbull, seconded by Magliocco. There was no further discussion. Motion passed unanimously.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Vazzano and seconded by Magliocco to adjourn the meeting at 3:30 p.m. The motion passed unanimously.

To All Personnel:

I would like to wish each and every one of you, and your families, a very happy and healthy holiday season.

In 2019, we witnessed some very impressive police work by many members of this Department. Major crimes were solved, rapid response to violent incidents prevented some from escalating even further and medical calls in which our First Responders handled saved lives. There is much to be proud of.

As we move forward to 2020, renovations will continue, which will finally permit the use of our indoor shooting range. The lockers and locker rooms are being utilized the cell doors are in place, providing more protection to each officer and safety to prisoners from self-harm.

We are also expanding the scope of the renovations to include furniture, painting and other work so that the facility is cleaner, more functional and presentable. The goal is to enhance as much of the facility as we can with the funding that is in place. Funding was not easy to come by, as you can imagine. The amount initially approved, fell far short of what was needed. We were then forced to go back to three Town Boards and seek additional funds so that the project could be completed. Board members were invited into see the conditions, a Power Point was presented and explanations were given by myself, AC Byrnes and the Architect so that nothing was missed and we gained approval of what was needed. As a final piece of work, we have funding in place for the entire parking area to be redone and expansion for additional spaces. This will not begin until all of the renovations to the building are completed.

Our budget process has begun for fiscal year 2020-2021. We are asking for funding to increase our abilities to train more, fund overtime adequately and hire additional officers. As most of you know, the budget process will take about six months for final approvals.

Once again, may you and your families have a happy healthy holiday and a prosperous 2020.




Trumbull Police Department 2018 Calls-For-Service, YTD










