


Call Volume



- Triage integration (in process)





- Still seeking increased staff in targeted areas.




Vehicles and Grounds

Ambulance 900 MVC, will be able to remount.

903 incident, useable, but will be repaired, loaner ambulance will be delivered as well to cover shortage.

905 replacement added to FY27 budget, will update as we move through budget process.
