1. RESOLUTION TC29-111: Moved by Hall, seconded by Satin
BE IT RESOLVED, That Jonathan B. Tropp, be and the same is hereby reappointed as a
member of the Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Task Force for a term extending to the
first Monday in December 2026 and is further reappointed Vice-Chairman of said Task
Force.

Jonathan Trop was present and indicated his party affiliation as democrat. He has found
the work of the committee to be important and interesting, and his contributions have
been appreciated and would like to continue.

2. RESOLUTION TC29-112: Moved by Lenzen, seconded by Mallozzi

BE IT RESOLVED, That David Rosenberg, be and the same is hereby reappointed as a member of the Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Task Force for a term extending to the first Monday in December 2026.

Mr. Rosenberg was unable to attend this meeting, but he will be at the Council meeting.

3. RESOLUTION TC29-113: Moved by Buswell, seconded by Mallozzi
BE IT RESOLVED, That Kalim Jan, be and the same is hereby appointed as a member of the Equity, Diversity and Inclusion Task Force for a term extending to the first Monday in December 2026.

Mr. Kalim Jan was present and indicated he has been a resident for the past 23 years with his wife and children and his party affiliation as independent. He has worked in the financial industry and for the last three years he has been a part of DEI as his work. What he has done at his job such as diversity and inclusion can be brought to the community. We can bring the community together and make it work for everybody.
