**Minutes of 1/30/20 Meeting**

A motion was made by the Chair, Commissioner T. Lee, and seconded by Commissioner Walkley, to approve the Minutes of the 1/30/20 meeting of the Commission. Reading of the Minutes was dispensed with. There was no discussion and Commissioner T. Lee, Commissioner Walkley, Commissioner Fullerton and Commissioner Slack approved the motion. Commissioner Lubin and Commissioner McCann abstained. ### **Vote of Commission on Complaint #2-2019**

Upon motion of Commissioner Lubin, seconded by Commissioner Walkley, the Commission found there to be probable cause with respect to Complaint #2-2019, in that the respondent's actions (including the possible violation of his oath of Polling Place Officials) may have violated Section III.A and III.B.3 of the Code of Ethics of the Town of Trumbull. The vote was unanimous.
