Old Business

Open Recreation: K. Bellows – There is a lot of support for having an “Open Rec” time. There was a survey sent out for more information. Based on our insurance, there cannot be use an “open rec” – it would need to be official (with potential fees) through the Recreation Department.

Question: J. O’Brien - Do we know what changed since “Open Rec” was available in town?

Response: R. Arganese – Just before 2020 you could show up, show your license/sign in and join.

Comment: Park Ranger – There were “supervisors” that were available during the “Open Rec” times. The Rangers would check in during these times and if necessary, PD would be called. There was no fee at one point.

Response: K. Bellows – We’ve never dealt with this as a commission, so this is new to us.

Beaches Park: K. Bellows – has there been any issue recently? Has there been any discussion on the signage that was mentioned during our last meeting?

Comment: S. Chapman – There have not been many issues any issues raised. Signs may be helpful but there are so many walkable entrances and some may come with ATVs or snow mobiles. Maybe cameras and signage will help to deter the issues. Closing it off could be an issue (and people do not necessarily want it closed off because it’s a cut through), but it is a park road versus a town road.

Question: D. Kroszner – Do we know if signage is in progress?

Response: K. Bellows – I didn’t get a chance to ask today but will find out.

5K Trail Run Request: K. Bellows – This request came through a few months ago. We asked Gaby L to speak with insurance, EMS, etc and have not heard back since. It was suggested that she connect with Recreation and Parks Superintendent has not heard an update as of yet. D. Paris is concerned about the safety of the trails. It looks as though it would start in the lot, around the lake and follow up to beach park road, then come back through another trail.

Response: S. Chapman – I’m trying to visualize. When we do things like the Sun Run, there are usually a number of people involved in keeping everyone safe along the trails, EMS stationed, police presence. We would need to

ensure that no one enters or leaves the parks when the running is happening for safety reasons. Running on natural trails can also be a concern.

New Business

- Field Use During Hillcrest Rebuild: R. Arganese – As far as Hillcrest being rebuilt and the fields that will be out of service – How are we going to provide access to all of the user groups in town that use these fields?

Response: K. Bellows – Right now, space is a problem and we have use of all of our fields. The responsibility will fall on Parks and Recreation as well as the Board of Education.

Response: S. Chapman – I'm not aware of this right now D. Paris and Kyle have been working on these logistics.

Response: N. Walsh – D. Paris did mention this in the November meeting, and it doesn't seem that right now there is a plan.

Comment: D. Kroszner – Maybe sending something proactively for these tournaments or special groups that want to come in – we send something saying it may not be possible.
