Moved by Cantafio, seconded by Miller to reduce 522202 Services & Fees Professional by \$215,000.

Reduction is due to the postponement of the revaluation.

Mr. Scinto spoke against this motion and stated this has been done in the past and was found to be a mistake.

Attorney Nugent explained for the Council this had come to be in the past 4-8 weeks as they looked at economic conditions in Town and the state in general. There were deliberations between himself, the Tax Assessor, outside Counsel Mario Coppola and a telephone conference with the Secretary of the Office of Policy & Management, (OPM) Melissa McCaw. Ms. McCaw stated she would support the Town's decision to postpone the 5-year revaluation for one year. The procedure is as follows: The town applies to OPM and they make the decision to grant the deferral. The decision is made by OPM, they have authority over the entire process, and there is no requirement of legislative action by the municipality. OPM requires the Tax Assessor to sign and accept the grand list and then the request is submitted to OPM that is why they had the conversation with secretary of OPM in advance to make sure they would support the decision. They were aware of the governor's order 7S regarding municipalities' revaluations but they felt there were more compelling factors that warranted a deferral this year.

Mr. Scinto spoke against the motion, due to the zoom meetings and the on-call, this would increase a spending cliff for next year.

Ms. Rosasco-Schwartz spoke against the motion because taking comp time by those that need to be on-call causes a ripple effect because they need to take additional time off.

### **522205 Program Supplies**

Moved by Klain, seconded by Mecca to increase 522205 Program Supplies by \$500,000

Mr. Klain thanked all those in town who emailed, texted and/or called the Council. Their voices were heard and it mattered a lot. It was his position to restore the First Selectman's BOE budget funded by offsetting cuts in the town and a limited draw on the general fund with a modest tax increase. When the BOE audit is completed they can then make hard decisions on any systemic problems in the schools' finance, but until we see the results of the audit we need to share sacrifice over time. He doesn't believe restoring the \$500,000 is enough, any additional federal, state money or efficiencies found in the BOE budget should be used for any remaining funding gap or services necessary to open the school. We have found more than enough reductions in this budget to pay for the proposal and cannot shift the entire burden because of administrative mistakes on the backs of the teachers, the schools would be disproportionately affected in which the whole town benefits from.

Mr. Lemoine stated the \$500,000 will help, it doesn't come close to the \$1.6 million already reduced. The current pandemic will put the school system in an unusual position and will require a lot of support from many areas. This is not the time to cut any part of the education budget. The democratic U.S. representative Johanna Hayes urged all the towns in CT not to cut education spending. They have received so many emails, calls and messages from the people. We can't overlook this. We know people come to town for the education system. We cannot short change the education system.

Mr. Marsh supports funding education but could not support this motion as presented, as it does an immediate good, but cautioned the long term impact of increasing town contribution to the BOE budget will have more of a negative impact next year when we are in the budget again. By increasing the town contribution we raise the bar that much more. Salaries and costs will go up next years as well. Revenues will be uncertain at best. He spoke in favor of realizing efficiencies, and supplement from the town side but doesn't support giving back the full \$500,000. That has nothing to do with what unions do. That is between the unions and the BOE. From a fiscal standpoint we need to keep liquidity in the general fund and flexibility to address unknown revenue shortfalls that may come down the road, we have seen it with mall recently. Putting more into the BOE is not a wise move, they are getting a 2.56% increase over last year in the height of a pandemic when most towns are zero budgeting BOE's. The republican BOF wanted to zero budget the BOE but First Selectman and the BOF found ways to give a substantial increase in a time of financial uncertainty and thinks we should support that.

Mr. Massaro spoke in favor of the motion because there is a lot of uncertainty in the budget. There are cuts in overtime accounts where services are needed. We have been budgeting with a lot of uncertainties over the past few years going back to 2017 when the state didn't adopt a budget until October and were granted extensions in recent years. One thing we should do is hold steady and eliminate as much consternation and risk. We certainly need our public

safety and are fully funding that. After this year’s budget is adopted he would recommend getting back to the Charter date of April 30<sup>th</sup> to alleviate the difficult position the BOE is when they have until May 1<sup>st</sup> to notify personnel of who won’t be renewed. There is a need to open society and the need for economics. Our local businesses have suffered and want to get the taxes back on track. With this reinstatement there is still a loss of \$1.6 million, there is work to still to be done by the BOE.

Ms. Rosasco-Schwartz echoed the comments made by Mr. Massaro, with this restoration of \$500,000, they are still \$1.6 million below what the BOE had requested. Given the uncertainty of when and how the schools will open and adding the costs of social distancing protocols and a heightened need for social and emotional support when the students return. It is unwise not to restore the funding.

Ms. Seidell stated on behalf of the programming for the students, she thinks about cutting reading consultants, math consultants and the paras that work in small groups if that disappears on any level the special education numbers and the retention numbers will go up unnecessarily. If these are kept in place and they get the foundation skills early they are fine the rest of the way through. She wanted to advocate for that. The Trumbull teachers as they implement distance learning, stepped out of the comfort zone and learned how to do recorded and live videos, flags should be raised for them.

Mr. Lemoine noted in January the democratic Town Committee Chair had stated \$1.2 million is a cost of \$100 per year for the taxpayer. \$500,000 will cost the taxpayer \$50 per year. There isn’t a resident in the town that would deny the school system \$50.

Ms. Valenti stated she is passionate about this restoration, it shows support of our teachers who have gone above and beyond through this pandemic. The funding that is coming down the road we will get, many of who advocated for this are taxpayers too and they are aware of the impact to their pocketbooks and are still advocating for it. She cannot ignore the 500 plus people who have reached out to them.

Mr. Klain stated that was the point of his motion because it disproportionately affects teachers through no fault of their own. We already ask a lot of them, with that he called the question.

The Chair noted to restore to the first selectman’s budget a 2/3 affirmative vote of the Council is necessary.

**522205 Program Supplies**

Moved by Gaudiano, seconded by Marsh to increase 522205 Program Supplies by \$224,000

Ms. Gaudiano extended her gratitude to all that had written to the Council, there were hundreds. As a mom of two children in the school system she too shares the concerns of the quality of the education. It has been her goal to fill the \$500,000 hole. It has also been the priority of her caucus with this pandemic and the current staggering unemployment rates that taxes remain stable. The motion does that using two mechanisms:

First it provides \$224,000 on top of the BOE allocation and;

It also takes into account the newly recognized \$276,000 in savings of a refinancing of a BOE loan.

Those two pools of money provide the BOE the \$500,000. In addition, the BOE will realize an additional \$213,000 in saving in a reduction in our insurance rate and \$158,000 from the CARES Act. In both instances they didn't factor those amounts into this proposal. This motion allows for keeping taxes stable. While \$45-\$60 may not seem a lot to most households there are many on fixed incomes, or who are on reduced and free lunches where that increase will make a difference in their budget. It is her hope this motion passes and the BOE administration looks for efficiencies and listens to the parents and educators. We don't have the luxury of continuously increasing funding to the BOE and raising taxes in a year-every year situation. As we have done this year I hope to continue to look for cost savings and maintain a quality school system that she knows she is proud to enroll her children in.

Mr. Lemoine stated he was sad the way this went tonight and questioned that \$500,000 couldn't be funded.

Mr. Scinto stated the budget is based on assumptions that is going to lead to a \$5 million spending cliff next year. The small amounts reduced tonight don't move the mill rate. \$500,000 of a \$140,000,000 budget is not a lot of money. School will start and we can't assume we have enough teachers. Assumptions equal a spending cliff.

Mr. Marsh stated they did find \$500,000 it was just done in a different way. This way the BOE is protected next year because if were to just give them \$500,000 that raises the bar to where we start next year because you can't give them less than any year. If we don't start them at a higher number we have more flexibility to address issues we don't know of yet. They are getting the equivalent of a 3% increase we just doing it in a different way. If we had our druthers we would give the BOE everything they want and more but we are in the height of an economic crisis, there is 14%-17% unemployment and that doesn't take into account underemployed people or who have had their salaries reduced. These are unusual times and are trying to provide short term relief to the BOE. There are other budgets down the road and a lot of economic uncertainty.

Ms. Colon stated she is a teacher and a mother. What she heard tonight is that they are still getting \$500,000 and Ms. Gaudio explained how very well.

Ms. Orenstein stated it is important to note that if they don't vote for the \$224,000 it will revert back to what the BOF recommended and urged everyone to vote yes for this compromise. She wanted the \$500,000 restored, she too received all of the emails and has always been an education advocate and voted yes for the \$500,000. She urged everyone to vote for the compromise, because with money found and savings the BOE is getting \$871,000 is back in this budget. Everyone agrees that there is nothing more important than education, but we want to make sure they don't end up with less.

Ms. Pires explained the savings from the town side reductions would have to be moved to the BOE by way of a supplemental if done after the budget process.

Mr. Whitmoyer stated he has been an educator in town for 20 years. In those 20 years no first selectman no matter which party they were ever gave the BOE what they asked for. To say the First Selectman is cutting the BOE budget bothers him as a taxpayer and a teacher because the First Selectman's job is to provide a budget that answers to everyone and supports everyone. He doesn't know of a department that got 100% of what they asked for in this budget. The BOF did cut the BOE budget to 2.5%, that said BOF sent a representative to renegotiate some BOE loans regarding energy and with their perseverance they came up with \$270,000, with that they are able to protect and take less form the general fund and keep that where it needs to be and take the difference to come up with \$224,000. This is called being creative and thinking out of the box and applauds everyone that has been involved because this has been one of the toughest budgets he has seen in 7 years and thanks everyone for getting us here and hopes all support this motion.

Mr. Miller stated we are beset with unpleasant choices all around, we have a mall revaluation that saddled us with \$750,000 less revenue this year, and we have a BOE that has been

underfunded for years. He is of the opinion they have to give the BOE more but that can't be done all at once. What is being done now is making hard choices and compromising. While we are trying to do everything we want and be financially responsible because we are in a financial crisis and at this point we don't know what is coming for the rest of the year. It's going to be a tight year, but we also have an education obligation, he moved here for the schools as did so many others. They have heard from so many parents and educators who want us to return the money, but we also have a huge financial burden this year and the best thing we can do us compromise. Every other department in town is not getting an increase this year, but the BOE is getting at least a 2.5% increase and through Ms. Gaudiano's motion they are going to get the full 3%. This seems to be a good way to govern and move forward.

Mr. Elstein spoke in favor of the motion, the \$500,000 seems steep but when you cobble together the savings and the cuts this makes a lot of sense, it supports the education system, the children, the teachers and the parents who know how important education is and fully supports the proposal.

The Chair explained the CARES Act has delivered a promise to the school system, which was referenced by Ms. Gaudiano earlier. In addition to the motion they will receive money to deal with COVID related expenses. The superintendent has the amount and the amount of the refinancing of the leases. It's not an assumption it is a reality. Ms. Gaudiano stated it is \$158,000 in CARES Act funding.

Mr. Klain stated he would be supporting this motion despite his desire to have the \$500,000. It would be unconscionable not to give the schools anything, this is better than nothing. Mr. Klain called the question.

Ms. Colon stated the BOE is still getting the money, all of it just in a different way.
