The Commission on Aging held a virtual meeting on Friday, June 25, 2021.

The meeting was called to order at 10:03 am by Mrs. Kelly followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Past Minutes:** Motion was made by Mr. Ryan to approve the minutes of May 28, 2021 as written. Seconded by Mrs. DaRold and approved.

**Secretary's Report**

**Director's Report**

Mrs. Jakab was unable to attend the meeting. Mrs. Kelly noted the Center is currently offering in-person classes and starting in July, there will be more activities available for the seniors. **New Business**

1. Mr. Ryan questioned when in-person meetings would be allowed. Mrs. Katske noted there is a new State Statute explaining the process. She is sending a letter to all Commission and Board chairs explaining the new guidelines. In-person meetings can resume in July with some

requirements. Mrs. Kelly will speak with Mrs. Jakab about potential locations for their Commission meetings in the future.

2. Mrs. Katske reviewed the guidelines for masks noting that anyone that is fully vaccinated does not have to wear a mask in Town buildings. This means two weeks post second shot or two weeks post one-dose vaccination. Anyone not fully vaccinated is required to wear a mask in Town buildings.

Mrs. Wiesner joined the meeting at 10:11 am.

3. Mr. Ganino questioned if it was possible to have some type of presentation at their next meeting that might be interesting to the seniors. Mrs. Kelly noted the Center has several program options available and that the Commission meeting may not be the right forum for presentations. Mrs. Katske encouraged the members to see what other commissions are doing in this regard. She and Mrs. Kelly will speak with Mrs. Jakab about options/ideas.
4. The Commission is still looking for one additional commissioner at this time.
5. Mrs. DaRold noted the Meals on Wheels lunch program is ending in June and the participants will now be going to the Center for pick-up.
6. Mrs. Heilbrunn noted she spoke with EMS Chief Goodman about a presentation on falling and balance. She will contact her again for further details. Mr. Ryan noted Bridgeport Hospital and Fairfield University also have such programs.
