Application 20-25 Jeanine Norwood

Permit approval to remove twenty (20) hazardous trees within a regulated area at 198 Old Dike Road.

Mary Blackburn, Solli Engineering spoke on behalf of the applicant and shared a powerpoint presentation. She provided an overview of the property. An arborist assessed the trees and found some to be strangled with ivy and root system failure. Ms. Blackburn went over the numerous types of trees that they wish to cut down and

the reasons why. She went over the planting plan. She said the stumps will all remain with the exception of 2. The tree company will use a telescoping crane to remove all the trees on the property. No heavy equipment will be used to access back of the property. Mary Ellen LeMay, spoke on behalf of the concerns of the Conservation Commission as it relates to the streamside trees holding the bank and requested a more detailed evaluation of the health of the trees. Jeanine Norwood, homeowner, was given the opportunity to speak but was unable to due to technical difficulties on her end. However, Ms. Blackburn did state that Ms. Norwood is extremely—— concerned that these trees will fall onto her home and these trees are a safety hazard. She has requested that the 7 trees closest to her house be removed as soon as possible.
