CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN NARRATIVE

STANDARD DEFINITION FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT

- Any acquisition or lease of land
- Purchase of major equipment or vehicles in excess of \$10,000 with life expectancy 3+ years
- Construction of new building facilities with cost in excess of \$10,000
- Major building improvements with a cost in excess of \$10,000
- Major equipment or furnishings in excess of \$10,000

BOARD OF EDUCATION

The Board of Education based their request on a capital improvement plan prepared by Savin Engineers, P.C., in September 2007. Per Superintendent Ralph Iassogna, most of the needs identified still remain unless emergency circumstances necessitated addressing a specific project. Facility Manager Al Barbarotta and Plant Administrator Steve Kennedy reviewed the plan and made updates as necessary to each respective school. See Exhibit A for the full proposal. The BOE Fleet and Equipment detail is listed separately.

ROADWAYS

A detailed listing of streets to be paved is attached. Streets were prioritized based on wear, safety, and usage for years 2012-2014. The cost is based on State of Connecticut bid prices from August 2010. Cost includes asphalt, tack, catch basin, manholes, curbing as needed, grading/compacting, loading and trucking of excess material. The amount shown for the remaining years is based on repaving of 8.06 miles of roadway per year (assumes total roadway of 201.45 miles divided by 25 year average service life).

PUBLIC FACILITIES

Costs are based on professional estimates from Antinozzi Associates. The items in their report that meet the criteria for capital improvements are listed here and labeled "Public Facilities – Capital". The items from the same report that are considered maintenance or operating costs are listed by site and labeled "Public Facilities – Maintenance". The maintenance or operating costs should be included in the General Fund budget. The total cost of both (Capital and Maintenance) corresponds to the Antinozzi Associates report totals found in Exhibit B.

The items below were requested by Department Heads and added to the Public Facilities – Maintenance schedule since the cost is less than the \$10,000 threshold for capitalization:

Town Hall – Tax Collector Security Camera System – vendor quote for \$3,410
Town Hall – Reorganization of Server Room – estimate from Technology Dept. for \$4,500

FLEET & EQUIPMENT

Detailed replacement schedules for each department are attached. Only items that were identified for replacement are included on the lists. The methodology for replacement was determined by each department. For example, the Trumbull Police Department replaces vehicles based on mileage. Patrol cruisers are replaced after 3 years or 75,000 miles within the warranty period. This policy reduces maintenance cost and ensures officer safety. Replaced police vehicles are typically rotated to other Town departments for use. Highway and Parks Departments replace equipment based on usage and condition. The vehicle may have rust and erosion due to road or work conditions that require replacement sooner than the recommended useful life. The general rule is to replace this equipment every 15 to 20 years. Cost estimates are based on State bid contracts or MSRP. The Senior Center buses need to be replaced every 5 years per State recommendation.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Various Sidewalk Projects - \$465,000

Sidewalks on Lower Main Street (\$135,000)

Sidewalks on Main Street from the Merritt Parkway (exit 48) to the Bridgeport Border. This is approximately .4 of a mile on each side. The sidewalk will improve the safety of residents walking to the shopping park, as well as protect students boarding buses on Main Street.

The sidewalks are needed for safety reasons as well as for the purpose of revitalizing the gateway of Trumbull from the Bridgeport border to the Merritt Parkway. Many residents with children have complained about the dangers of having their children walk to the school bus stop on Main Street because there are no sidewalks. Without sidewalks risks may potentially increase as some of the homes on Main Street convert to professional offices (as is allowed by zoning code) and the mall expands. The Planning and Zoning Commission has also expressed interest in sidewalks in this area.

Sidewalks on Whitney Avenue from Main Street to Indian Ledge Park (\$195,000)

The purpose is to provide greater safety and pedestrian connectivity between the park, the Rails to Trails, and the commercial lifestyle area at Long Hill Green. Sidewalks will only be implemented on the south side of Whitney. Estimated length is ½ mile. Costs include blasting, leveling, and some potential movement of utilities. The Planning and Zoning Commission has expressed interest in sidewalks in this area.

Sidewalks on Main Street from Whitney Avenue to Gisella Road (\$135,000)

The purpose is to provide greater safety and foster more pedestrian oriented transit in the Long Hill Green Mixed Use District and to the Rails-to-Trails and Indian Ledge section of Whitney Avenue. Sidewalks will only be implemented on the south side of Whitney. Estimated length is ½ mile. The Planning and Zoning Commission has expressed interest in sidewalks in this area.

Paving of the Trumbull Corporate Park – Merritt Boulevard - \$105,000

Repaving of the Corporate Park is long over due, and businesses have complained about the tired and unsafe appearance of the park for several years. The purpose is to improve Trumbull's competitiveness against neighboring towns with newer, more upgraded business parks so that we are better able to attract and retain our business tax base at Trumbull Corporate Park.

Trumbull has the opportunity to receive \$320,000 in federal transportation funding to repave the longest of the three roads, Merritt Boulevard, as long as the project is completed by June 30, 2011. Federal funding prohibits reimbursement for the cost of design work (\$25,000). The Town would need to provide a twenty percent match to the federal funding in the amount of \$80,000. The total Town investment would be \$105,000 and the federal funding would be \$320,000. See below for additional repaving to Trumbull Corporate Park.

Paving of the Trumbull Corporate Park – Nutmeg Drive and Commerce Drive - \$200,000

See above summary. Due to funding regulations, the federal grant will not cover the cost of paving the adjoining roads of Nutmeg Drive and Commerce Drive as part of the Merritt Boulevard project. Paving consists of approximately 1.5 miles of road (Merritt Boulevard, Nutmeg Drive, and Commerce Drive).

Proposed paving amounts for Sewer Project Contracts III and IV were not available at the time of this report.

Emergency Exit at the Trumbull Corporate Park - \$50,000

Purpose is to provide an emergency exit out of the Corporate Park(onto Route 8) in the event of a catastrophic incident. This has been requested by several of the businesses that are currently located in the Corporate Park. In addition, the lack of an emergency exit has been an expressed concern of prospective businesses over the past few years. The access would be opened by Town or State emergency officials only.

Nature Center & Ranger Station - \$1,100,000

5,000 square foot facility to encompass both the new Nature Center and Ranger Station. The facility will replace two existing facilities. Cost includes equipment from existing facilities including playground and solar panels, transported from existing sites to new facility. Location to be determined. Preliminary cost estimate was provided by Antinozzi Associates based on RS Means for square footage.

White Plains Road Engineering Traffic Study - \$25,000

Study and design for traffic calming on White Plains Road near Trumbull Center to make area more pedestrian friendly and safe.

Reservoir Avenue Design and Best Use Analysis - \$40,000

The purpose of this study is to provide the Town's land use boards with data that enables them to make educated decisions on the best use for this area. Due to changing market and economic conditions, the town is likely to be confronted with applications that may not be in line with the Plan of Conservation or the Zoning Code, which were adopted under very different conditions. The analysis will determine if zoning regulations should change to reflect the current conditions.

PARK IMPROVEMENTS

Park improvements are necessary for the functioning and usefulness of the recreational facilities and for safety purposes. Costs are estimated based on manufacturer quotes or professional estimate. Project costs are spread out over several years where feasible.

Abraham Nichols Barn Roof Replacement - \$15,000

Historic facility used by Parks and Historical Society for storage. Replacement of roof shingles needed to protect the equipment and materials being stored.

Twin Brooks Beach Parking Lot - \$29,700

Resurface and repair the parking lot at site. Cost estimated at 330 tons of material x \$90/ton.

OTHER PROJECTS

Highway Salt Shed - \$175,000

Enclosure for salt/sand pile required to comply with DEP regulations.

Highway Pre-engineered Garages - \$400,000

Garages to accommodate new fleet of plows and other equipment.

Transfer Station Improvements - \$250,000

Heating is needed onsite to protect the mechanical components and operations. The building has sustained structural damage that needs further investigation to repair. Doors need to be repaired or replaced. The Main Hopper need repair. Paint, lighting, signage, and curbing stops and bumpers are also recommended safety improvements.

Town Hall Window Shutters - \$20,000

The Town received ARRA funding through the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant program for window replacement at Town Hall. The shutters are not an eligible cost and would be prudent to complete at the same time as the window replacement for labor cost savings.

Berkshire Avenue Storage Garage - \$60,000

Part of the structure will be repurposed as the Emergency Management storage and staging facility. The cost will replace the roof to ensure this equipment is protected as well as the Voter Registration's materials and equipment.

Engineering Survey Equipment - \$18,000

Replacement of 40 year old survey equipment: Leica TPS1200 Total Station, Allegro Data Collector, 3 tripods and 3 prisms. The existing equipment is antiquated and performs erratically. The

equipment also requires more time to use and is prone to errors. New equipment will provide efficiency and free up staff to work on other projects.

Tax Collector Cashier Security Counter - \$10,000

Security partitions and counters for Tax Collector office including ergonomic furniture. Security for this office is a top priority based on Internal Audit report. Specs prepared by in-house engineer and cost estimate based on vendor quotes.

Reconfiguration of Town Clerk Office Space - \$10,065

Search terminals are currently located in the vault due to space limitations in violation of State Law. The plan would reconfigure the office to include part of the unused hallway for search terminals and open up the area to increase visibility to meet safety and customer service needs. Design specs and cost estimate prepared by in-house engineer.

Town Clerk Vault Shelving - \$12,000

Replace storage shelving in vault that is unusable due to layout. State Law governs how documents must be stored and made accessible. Cost is estimated.

Trumbull Main Library Furnishings - \$28,000

Modernize public library facilities with replacement of furnishings. Replace furnishings over 35 years old with modern rectangular tables and chairs for patron use. Cost estimated at \$1,000 each table x 10 tables and 40 chairs at \$250 each. Comfortable stuffed chair seating to scatter throughout library for quiet reading similar to bookstore layouts. Stuffed chairs estimated at \$1,000 each for 8 chairs.

Highway GPS - \$71,550

GPS will be installed in Public Works vehicles. The system will be used for safety; fleet and personnel management. Cost is based on vendor quote of \$435 for a one-time start up fee per vehicle and another \$360 annual cost per vehicle x 90 vehicles at time of purchase. After the first year, \$32,400 (\$360 per vehicle x 90 vehicles) will need to be budgeted for service and maintenance contract expense.

Highway Wash Bay - \$150,000

To replace inoperable wash bay used to clean and maintain all Town vehicles. Currently there is no hot water or pressure washing available. The structure will not accommodate the larger Public Works trucks, which need to be thoroughly cleaned of salt and debris for operational safety and fuel efficiency. The cost is based on use of in-house labor to construct a new bay.

Senior Center Additional Parking - \$30,360

Project would remove the playground which is not used by the seniors and add 69 additional parking spaces.

Town-wide Energy Audit - \$50,000

Funding for consulting firm to perform formal energy audit of town facilities and determine cost-effective energy efficient programs and solutions.

EMS Radio System - \$250,000

The FCC mandate for narrowband compliance will make current communications system being used illegal after December 31, 2013. To bring the system into compliance for use the Town needs to purchase and install new base stations and compliant portable devices at EMS headquarters. The deadline is not expected to be extended again by the FCC. Cost based on estimate from vendor.

PUBLIC SAFETY

Communication Center - \$1,550,000

Jacunski Humes Architects, LLC, has drafted plans for a redesigned communication center. Discussions are in process for a regional center to incorporate Trumbull, Monroe and Easton. Even if the regional center moves forward, the current communication equipment is reaching the end of its warranty life expectancy and will be obsolete and need to be upgraded to a Digital System. An equipment upgrade is necessary for the 2011-12 budget year.

Cell Block Modifications - \$100,000

Replace the barred cells with clear, heavy plastic cell doors to offer greater visibility for both officer and prisoner safety.

Locker Room Expansion - \$200,000 (included in Antinozzi Report – See Public Facilities Capital)

Replace existing lockers and expand locker room to accommodate the needs of sworn officers and civilian personnel. Due to a lack of space, lockers presently line the hallway in the basement causing a safety issue. Lockers are sized too small to accommodate critical equipment and uniform storage.

Perimeter Fencing - \$65,000

Fencing to secure the area behind the facility. Currently non-authorized private vehicles can drive through this area to exit the parking lot. Approximately 984 linear feet of high chain link fencing is needed with two sliding gates operated by a card key.

Radio Amplification System - \$90,000

Radio amplification system for Trumbull High School area to allow police to communicate via radio when responding to school incidents.

Police Annex Building - \$200,000

A 24 x 30 foot cinder block and brick face building is needed on the rear of the property to offer a secure area for processing impounded vehicles and storage.

TECHNOLOGY

Technology projects are those identified as critical and necessary for the continued secure operation of the Town. The projects have been prioritized by the Technology Department. A brief description of each follows:

Domain Recovery / Server & Storage – State regulations require off site server and storage along with a disaster recovery plan for Town data. Off site location identified is Senior Center Building.

Domain Controllers – Used to validate credentials when logging into computer system. Currently controllers are not redundant (no backup system).

Email Server Support – Current server does not support all of Town. Upgrade necessary.

Storage Infrastructure – Upgrade and centralize storage infrastructure to accommodate the growing amount of electronic data from paperless office transactions.

Network Consultant – Analysis of Trumbull's data and IT infrastructure to make recommendations on modernizing system to meet future technology needs.

Time & Attendance System – Card and biometric identification system used to track employee work hours to be integrated with financial system. Cost based on vendor quote for equipment, software, implementation and training. Includes first year of system maintenance.

Wireless Network – Network to allow all Town buildings access to system.

ENTERPRISE

Tashua Knolls Golf Course projects were proposed by the General Manager based on priorities set by the Commission. Cost estimates were provided by TKGC and spread out over several years when applicable.
