Since 2007, Mr. Estrada has served as the Vice President of Facilities Planning and Construction for the University of Bridgeport. In this role, he led a \$100 million capital and infrastructure campaign that transformed the university campus.

Prior to his employment with the University of Bridgeport, Mr. Estrada served as the Director of Public Facilities for the City of Bridgeport where he successfully streamlined department operations, improved customer service, and engaged residents for neighborhood revitalization efforts. With his extensive public and private sector experience, Mr. Estrada has maintained a lifelong career that delivers results-oriented successful campaigns to promote economic development, improve public safety, and preserve environmental resources.
