The medical field is very specialized these days but it is important to have a primary care physician. When you start to look for a physician the titles can be confusing. There are different titles for primary care doctors. A Family Care Doctor is also called a Primary Care Doctor. An Internist is a primary care doctor who takes care of adolescents and adults. In 1998, a new subspecialty in primary care was instituted called Gerontology. Geriatricians have one to two years of specialized training and take care of older adults usually over 65 years of age. It might seem difficult to find a new doctor because it is. The number of primary care physicians has declined over the years.
