Head out to Lake Chaubunagungamaug or more easily pronounced as Webster Lake for a fun-filled day of exploration.

Enjoy a cruise on **Indian Princess**. Docked at Indian Ranch, The Indian Princess is a modern day replica of the grand riverboats that plied the Mississippi River in the late 19th century. Cruising out of Webster, MA, she is one of the few authentic paddlewheel riverboats still in operation in the United States today. In keeping with early traditions, she was built with stern wheels that are her only means of propulsion. The Indian Princess has split stern wheels each ran by a twin diesel engine that powers hydraulic motors to turn the paddles. This is in contrast to most Mississippi River paddle wheelers in operation today that have a "freewheeling" paddle wheel at the stern of the boat for the visual effect but have traditional screw type engines hidden for their real means of propulsion.

Then, enjoy **lunch** in **Indian Ranch's new Waterfront Dining Room** which sits overlooking the lake. Choose between: Chicken Marsala, Steak Tips or Baked Fish. The menu also includes: Garden Salad with House Dressing, Warm Rolls with Butter, Chef's Choice of Vegetable, Chef's Choice of Starch, Coffee, Tea, Water, Iced Tea, Lemonade, and Dessert.

This afternoon, have some **free-time** to shop at **Foppema's Farm**. Foppema's Farm is a 75 acre fruit and vegetable farm located in Northbridge, Massachusetts. The farm is family owned and operated by the Ken Foppema family. Ken and Lisa and their four sons (along with a wonderful staff of employees) grow and sell produce from the farm out of a beautiful post and beam building (built in 1998).
