Wood Ashes - Cold	Use in your Compost pile (very small amount), as an insect repellant (sprinkle small amounts around the perimeter of your garden to deter slugs and snails), or apply to your soil if you need to raise the pH
Wrapping Paper - Foil	Reuse if in good condition; if not, trash
Wrapping Paper - Paper	Reuse if in good condition; if not, trash
Yard, Garden Trimmings	Leave on lawn; Transfer Station
Yoga mat	Donate if in good condition to a community center/senior center or animal shelters to use in cages. If not, trash
