

HOW TO DO A MUNICIPAL SEARCH /PERMIT SEARCH FOR A PROPERTY

Go to Town of Trumbull website- www.trumbull-ct.gov, Government, Building Dept.

On the left side column click the link MUNICIPAL SEARCH

A new screen will appear with letters A-Z and link to email to submit request

Select the letter the street starts with

Find the street name- click on it

The permit card for the ENTIRE Street will populate with addresses & permits taken out by date issued, not by specific address

Look under the column for house number, find the house number you are looking for and follow the column across to permit number & description of work permitted.

At the top of the page is a link with the email address you need to submit to. Please include the complete permit numbers and any letters.

We will respond to your email with the permit status and send you anything new (permits after 12/2013 & mechanicals from 2007 to present)

*******We only have permits in the office from 1971 to Present. Anything else is just information on the card and may not have the address noted but homeowners name only. *******

Section 1. Section 29-265 of the general statutes is amended by adding subsection (c) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2017*):

(NEW) (c) Nine years from the date of issuance of a building permit issued pursuant to section 29-263 for construction or alteration of a one-family dwelling, two-family dwelling or structure located on the same parcel as a one-family dwelling or two-family dwelling, for which construction or alteration a certificate of occupancy, as defined in the regulations adopted pursuant to section 29-252, has not been issued by the building official, such building permit shall be deemed closed.
