

NoveList Plus helps Trumbull Library System patrons find book suggestions, through various genre & theme categories, “read-alike” recommendations, and lists arranged by author or series.

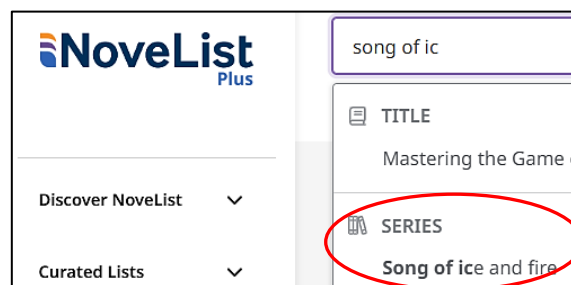
## Getting started:

- Go to **www.trumbull-ct.gov/Library** and click the *Research Center* button.
- Scroll down to the *Reading* category, and then click on *Novelist Plus*.
- If you’re prompted for a number, enter the 14-digit barcode number from the back of your Trumbull Library System card.



## Find what book comes next in a series:

- Start typing the name of the series in the search box at the top of the page. Matching results will appear as you type, and you can click on one of them, or hit *enter* to see all results.
- Click on the title of the series, and you’ll be taken to the detail page for the series.
- Or, you can search for a specific book in the series, click on the result, and then click on the link for its series.
- Once you are on the detail page for the series, scroll down to the heading *Books in this Series*. You can sort the list by recommended reading order, or publication date.

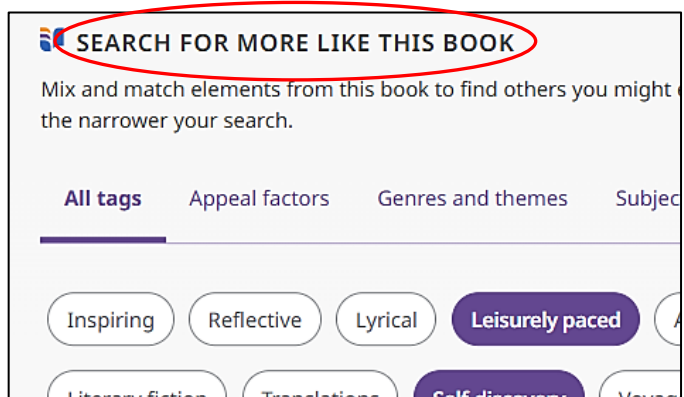
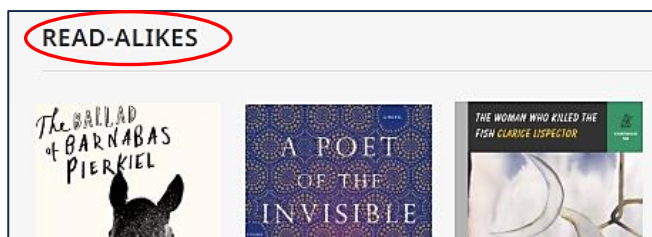
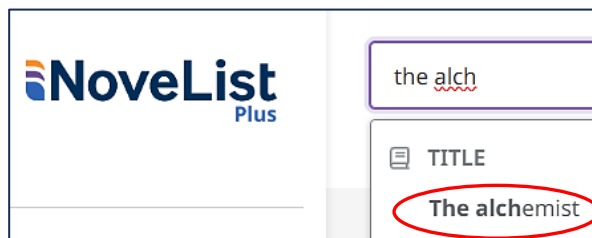
## Mix and match elements to find the perfect book for you:

- On the left sidebar, click *Discover NoveList* and then *Appeal factors index*. These are story elements related to mood, character identities, writing style, and more. You can click on one to find matching books.
- Or you can search for multiple appeal factors at the same time by clicking *Advanced Search* at the top-right of any page. Enter the term(s) in the search box(es) and make sure to select *Appeal Factors – AP* from the dropdown menu. For example, let’s say you want stories with a nonlinear plotline and an action-packed mood →



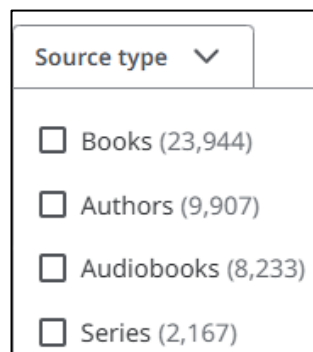
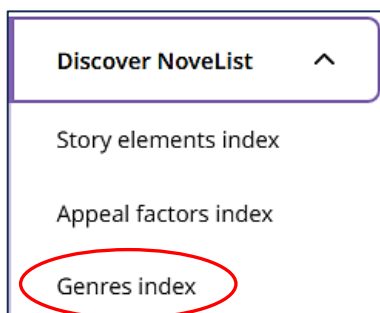
### Find an author/book/series that's similar to one you already like:

- Start typing the name of an author/book/series in the search box. Matching results will appear as you type, and you can click on one of them, or hit *enter* to see all results.
- On the detail page for the author/book/series, scroll down to the *Read-Alikes* heading to find a list.
- You can also scroll further down to find the section *Search For More Like This Book (or Author/Series)*. Click on any of the listed elements to search for matching books.



### Browse by genre:

- In the left sidebar, click *Discover NoveList* and then *Genres Index*.
- Click on any of the genres or subgenres to see matching books.
- You can limit the results by clicking the *Source Type* dropdown menu, for example if you only want to see audiobooks.



### See What's New or Popular:

- Scroll down the homepage to the *Books with Buzz* heading to see books that have recently been mentioned in the media or recommended by celebrity book clubs.
- Or scroll down the homepage to see the *Curated Lists* heading. (This is also available in the left-hand sidebar.) Here you'll find book lists categorized by trending topics, the time of year, or specific interests.
- Or go to the left-hand sidebar, click Quick Links then *Book club best bets*.

### Get Notified About Newly-Added Books that Match Your Interests:

- After running a search in NoveList, look at the results list and click the 3 dots at the top-right. Select *Create Alert*.
- You will need to create a **free** MyEBSCO account to use this feature, so click *Sign In* and then *Create an Account*.
- On the *Create Search Alert* page, you can choose to receive alerts daily, weekly, or monthly. You'll start receiving emails whenever new books are added to NoveList that match this search.
