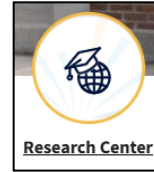


Start at [www.trumbull-ct.gov/Library](http://www.trumbull-ct.gov/Library) and click on the *Research Center* button.



Scroll down to the *Newspapers* section. From here, you can access individual newspapers as well as newspaper collections, which include articles from many different publications. Just click on one of the titles, and if you're prompted for a number, then enter the 14-digit barcode number from the back of your Trumbull Library card.

On each newspaper page, you can type search words in the box and hit *Enter* to see the results. On the results page, you'll see more options either at the top or on the left sidebar, allowing you to limit the results by date.

Some newspapers have an additional option of browsing articles by issue or date, and will either display a dropdown menu or a list of dates. If the newspaper has multiple editions/versions, click the *Publications* link first, then click on a version, then select a date from the dropdown menu.

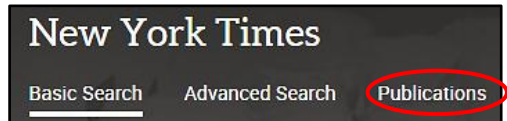

## Newspaper collections:

*America's News* (from **NewsBank**.)

Articles and transcripts from over 4,000 newspapers, wire services, and TV/radio news. American sources only.

*MasterFile Premier* (from **EBSCOhost** )

Articles from over 1,500 newspapers, magazines, and scholarly journals. Also includes biographies, reference books and primary source documents. Both American and international sources.

*Newspaper Source Plus* (from **EBSCOhost** )

Articles from over 1,000 newspapers and wire services, and over 1 million TV/radio news transcripts. Both American and international Sources.

On each collection page, you can type search words in the box and hit *Enter* to see the results. On the results page, you will see additional options either at the top or on the left sidebar, allowing you to limit the results by date or source type.

## Viewing the Trumbull Times:

- Click on *Trumbull Times* and you'll be taken to a start page for that paper.
- Note: This link doesn't always work as expected, and sometimes goes to the full list of newspapers instead. If you see a page called *A-Z Source List*, click on the letter T, and then *Trumbull Times*.**
- Under *View Recent Issues* you can click a date to see all articles from that issue.
- Under *Browse Issues by Date*, you can select a year in the dropdown menu and then click on a month/date to see all articles from that date.
- To search for a particular article or topic, enter your search words in the box at the top of the page. Then click the *Search* button.

## Viewing the Connecticut Post:

- Click on *Connecticut Post* and you'll be taken to a start page showing 3 collections, each with a different date range and format:
  - Connecticut Post (Bridgeport, CT)* – Displays the full page of the paper, with images, as it looked in print. Covers 2019 to the present.
  - Connecticut Post (CT)* – Displays the text of the articles only, without images. Covers 2001 to the present.
  - Connecticut Post: Web Edition Articles (Bridgeport, CT)* – Displays articles that appeared on the ctpost.com website, as text only, without images. Covers 2015 to the present.
- You can click on an individual collection to browse issues by date. Or, to search for a particular article or topic (across all 3 collections), enter your search words in the box at the top of the page. Then click the *Search* button.
