

## Frequently Asked Questions

### 1. Is participation mandatory?

No. Participation in the T-SNAP program is completely voluntary. If you or a family member has special needs, you are encouraged to participate. Think of it as helping police, fire and EMS personnel to help you.

### 2. How much will it cost me?

There are no fees for the T-SNAP program.

### 3. My needs may change. Can I update the information after my initial submission?

Yes. You are encouraged to update the information annually.



### 4. Will the information be shared with anyone other than emergency responders?
